Topic 1.

They have questions about the criminal conflicts of interest laws and OGE's role in enforcing them. How do we work with DOJ? (Jen told them that our role was not in enforcing but in interpreting and providing guidance pursuant to a MOU with DOJ, but said someone else could provide more detail on OGE's authority and role with regard to the CCOI laws.) They referred to a '83 memo and a '74 letter and asked if we knew of any guidance outside of those. They referred to a list of laws compiled by CRS and wanted to know if we could look at it and comment on whether we knew of anything missing. They followed up by sending the document.

They also asked about changes OGE recently made to our regulations, particularly interested in the gift rules.

Topic 2.

They wanted to know more about the process of reviewing and resolving incoming executive branch senior officials' potential conflicts of interest. Wanted to know how the process originated, does it originate with the official going directly to OGE? (Jen told them it did not originate that way but said someone else could provide more detail on the process.) What is OGE's role?

Topic 3.

Asked about recent tweets. Is it common practice? (We did not comment on this question at all.)

Topic 4.

What is the policy for removing the Director of OGE? Is it a five year term? Is it only for cause? What power does the President have to remove the Director? (Jen said only that the Director is a PAS with a five year term, and it was her understanding that the intention was that making it a five year term would prevent the Director's position from being open during a transition period, because of the important role that OGE plays in the presidential nominee process.)
