The guidance addresses the performance indicators that agencies listed in 31 U.S.C. § 901(b)(1) must incorporate into their Annual Performance Plans, starting with FY 2019. We highly recommend that agency Regulatory Policy Officers and Regulatory Reform Officers (RRO) coordinate with their Performance Improvement Officers (PIOs) on implementing the guidance, and recommend you send a copy of the guidance to your PIOs. In addition, thanks to many of you who provided contact information for your agency's newly minted Regulatory Reform Officers. I have attempted to add all of them to this email distribution, but if I missed the RRO or your point of contact for this initiative, please forward.

The guidance also addresses the information OMB will need to consider agency requests for waivers from EO 13777. Please note that EO 13777 applies to all agencies subject to the regulatory review requirements of EO 12866; therefore, agencies not listed in 31 U.S.C. § 901(b)(1) but subject to EO 12866's regulatory review requirements must obtain a waiver if they are not to comply with the other, still applicable parts of EO 13777. We do note that several of your agencies have already submitted waiver requests. We are taking a close look at them now and hope to get back to you soon. For agencies who are planning on sending a waiver request, please send those to your agency's OIRA desk officer.

OIRA would be happy to answer any follow-up questions you may have about the guidance: it is probably most efficient to direct any questions to your OIRA desk officer. Have a great weekend.

I hope all is well with you.

Pursuant to statute, OGE updates its gift and travel reimbursement reporting threshold every three years to correspond to GSA's adjustments to the definition of "minimal value" in the Foreign Gifts and Decorations Act (\$375 to \$390). An exception to our widely attending gathering gifts regulations have also been tied to that value since their first issuance. These routine amendments have been deemed nonsignificant rules under EO 12866 in past updates. Therefore, this final rule is not considered an "EO 13771 regulatory action." Our goal is to send the notice to the *Federal Register* in the next week or so.

Consistent with past practice, we are sending the final rule to you for your informal review. I am happy to discuss this if you have any comments or questions. Thanks,

Agencies are reminded of the following requirements in OMB Circular A-11, section 124, related to planning for a possible lapse in appropriations:

"124.2 What plans should my agency make in anticipation of a lapse in appropriations? "Agency heads, in consultation with their general counsels, must develop and maintain plans for an orderly shutdown in the event of a lapse in appropriations. Up-to-date plans must be on file with OMB. Whenever there is a change in the source of funding for an agency program or any significant modification, expansion, or reduction in agency program activities, the agency must submit an updated plan to OMB for review that reflects this change. In updating their plans, agencies also should note any changes made to their plans in light of their experiences during any recent lapse in appropriations. At a minimum, agencies should submit updated plans to OMB for review every two years, starting August 1, 2015..."

Please work with your agency to submit an updated plan to your OMB examiner **by August 1**, with a copy to <u>section124plans@omb.eop.gov</u>. Additional information about agency planning is available in section 124 of Circular A-11,
